In the past 12 years, Heritage Soccer Club has grown from 5 to 30 teams. In addition, Heritage has

seen over 50 players compete collegiately including one player playing professionally with Republic FC, Sacramento. Currently 3 HSC teams are playing in the top league in Northern California.

Key Demographics

ith players coming from all corners of Contra Costa County, Heritage Soccer Club attracts players and families from a wide cross section of demographics. With the highest percentage of players from Martinez to Antioch, Heritage provides potential exposure to a large community of young and extended families in a valuable market.

Total number of players registered:

Academy - ages 4-8: 40

Competitive teams- ages 8-18: 455

As a family based organization, in addition to players on the field, a significant number of extended family members as spectators line the field to watch games. Games are played all over California and Nevada with the majority in the SF Bay area. Players and supporters for home and visiting teams number upwards of 50 per game, with an average total of 45 games played per year with 30 teams, the exposure is far reaching. Games are every weekend from March through November. During the winter, teams play indoors, extending the season. With games played back to back, players and families arrive 45 minutes before game time and stay afterwards for game closure and talks as well.

By the numbers this means that Heritage Soccer Club players, families and spectators are at fields displaying Heritage and supporter colors and logos at 1350 events each year with exposure to approximately 135,000 home and away players and supporters.

A Cause that's Good for Your Brand

Heritage Soccer Club is a non-profit 501 (c)(3) that focuses on children by providing a youth soccer program to just under 500 players. Heritage makes every effort to provide an equal opportunity for underserved and financial disadvantage families to participate in our youth soccer development programs.

For 2015, we had 74 applications for financial aid and were able to provide 57 with a financial award ranging from \$50 to \$1395 per player. Almost all of these families have incomes under \$50K with 35% of the funds helping families with incomes under \$20K including unemployment. Several of these families are also supported by their coaches who also help cover their costs. We do not have nearly enough funds to help families as much as we'd like, and work with coaches to come up with additional ways we can help. For all applicants we extend their monthly payments over the season to help lower their monthly costs.

In addition, we sponsor our youth soccer players, 14 years of age or older, who wish to become soccer referees. Over 30 youth players have passed our 18 hour referee course in the past 2 years covering over 1000 referee slots while getting paid for each game they work. This program requires our youth to develop leadership skills as well as responsibility. They must be one time, prepared and professional. Experienced adult referees mentor them as they gain confidence dealing with challenges and adversity. As a result, this year we are seeing a 15% increase in youth referees signing up to referee game slots from last year. We are very proud to see them grow and learn from this experience.

We believe that we provide an environment for our athletes to understand and embrace teamwork, hard work, practice, competition, commitment, communication and collaboration both in practices and on the playing filed. These are all baseline skills that we know future employers will find attractive.
